To be added to Level 3's potential vendor bid list, please complete the supplier registration documents. Email your completed documents to your Level 3 contact, with a copy to supplierdiversity@level3.com.

DIRECT GOVERNMENT REPORTING

As part of Level 3's commitment to supplier diversity, we require our large, non-diverse suppliers receiving in excess of \$650k for any one project (\$1 million for construction) from Level 3 to have their own diversity programs established. Level 3's large subcontractors must submit reports via eSRS and are responsible for obtaining, approving and monitoring the subcontracting plans of lower-tiered subcontractors. If your company qualifies, please work with Level 3 Global Procurement for reporting requirements.
